What to Wear

Weather-Wise

With an elevation of only 3,033 feet and the top of Big Mountain Ski Resort at only 7,000 feet, there is no acclimation to elevation when visiting Whitefish. The area climate is relatively mild year round. Summer temperatures average in the high 70's, but the evenings are cool. The average temperature for the coldest month of the year is in the 20's as compared to the other side of the Continental Divide, where the average is 15 degrees colder. The wind hardly ever blows in Whitefish! You know it's true by looking at the fence posts—the snow piles straight up!
