CROSS COUNTRY SKIING AND SNOWSHOEING:

The Glacier Nordic Center (Whitefish Lake Golf Course) Groomed. Trail fee is \$ 8 for 13 yrs and older; under ski for free. Season passes are also available \$45 single, \$90 family. No snowshoeing or dogs.

Round Meadows N Hyw 93 about 7 miles turn west unto Farm to Market Rd, go 1.2 miles and turn unto Star Meadows Rd. *ungroomed and no charge.*

SNOWMOBILING:

Olney/Red Meadow: (North of Whitefish on Hwy 93)

70 miles of open-field play terrain winding from Olney, up and
over Werner Peak at 7,100 ft., up and over Big Mountain Resort,
and down into Canyon Creek to Columbia Falls... connects to
Upper Whitefish Lake Trail and Stryker Trail...one of the longest
loops to take in one day.

Upper Whitefish Lake: (North of Whitefish on E.Lakeshore
Dr.) Groomed trail riding as well as unlimited mountain climbing
and play in open meadows...connects to trails from Olney &
Mount Marston, 50 mi tour through the Whitefish Mtn Range

Canyon Creek: (5 miles north of Columbia Falls) Trail
leads to summit of Big Mtn, where snowmobilers are welcome to
relax, have lunch and enjoy the views of Glacier National Park
and the Flathead Valley... continue past Big Mtn. to Upper
Whitefish Lake and into Kimberly Basin, ...110 miles in length
